- *Celebrity Flora* is one of the most energy-efficient ships in the Galapagos, with a 15% reduction of fuel consumption and equivalently fewer air emissions due to the introduction of an advanced propulsion system, unique hull configuration and specially designed engines
- The anchorless technology maintains the ship's position while protecting the sensitive sea floor. This dynamic positioning system is a first in the Galapagos
- Zero-speed stabilizers promise smooth and efficient sailing
- Single-use plastics have been reduced by 90% onboard *Celebrity Flora*
- Water conservation is prioritized with in-room water filtration stations, as well as converting sea water and A/C condensation into water for laundry
- All materials that can be recycled, reused or donated will be as part of a strict waste management system
- Guests are invited to make donations to the Galápagos Fund, which Celebrity Cruises manages in partnership with the Galápagos Conservancy
- Food purchasing and usage are measured on an ongoing basis to ensure efficiency to minimize food loss
- All waste is segregated onboard, including food, aluminum, glass and paper.
- *Celebrity Flora's* food and beverage team is committed to locally sourcing ingredients
- Sophisticated inventory management and consumption tools are used to ensure appropriate amounts of food to achieve minimal waste
